Grades 6 – 8 Information for MSYG

Middle School Youth Group is next week February 24th. Middle School Youth Group will be doing Stations of the Cross. Each class will be assigned a station to act out and given a list of props available for your group to use. These will be **STILL** stations, meaning your group will walk on stage, freeze for the reading, and walk off after the reading. Your class will be given 15- 20 minutes of prep time at the beginning of youth group. These should be **SIMPLE** stations so your group will not need more preparation than that. Listed below is the station assigned to your group and the format of how the night will work.

Format for Stations of the Cross

- Each group will assign a reader (or two) to read your stations given text.
- Your group will **Enter** on the **Left** side of the stage (closest to parish offices) and exit on the right side stage
- Props will be available on the side of the stage
- Group members will freeze in their position on stage
- Reader(s) will read first text **Pause Briefly** and read second text
- When music starts group **Exits** off the **Right** side of stage (closest to cafeteria)
- The next group will wait on the side of the stage for their station
