

Rules and Regulations
St. Francis Xavier and St. Mark's Cemeteries
Buffalo, MN 55313

1. No monuments or markers may be set without prior permission from the Parish Office.
2. Flowers, wreaths, and appropriate veteran's decorations will be allowed from May 1 to December 1.
3. Artificial, cut flowers, and plants in urns must be placed on a cement platform, limited to one planter per grave stone. The same regulations apply to single post elevated-type plant stands. Winter decorations, allowed from December 1 must be removed by May 1, or will be removed by the caretaker.
4. All flowers and plants must be in approved containers and not be dug into the ground. Glass jars or spiked funnels are not allowed.
5. All watering must be done manually. Wilted or faded floral arrangements and dried up plants will be removed by the caretaker.
6. Trees, bushes, or shrubs may be planted only with the express permission of the Parish Office in designated areas.
7. The Cemetery Committee reserves the right to remove any and all decorations, urns, vases, etc., not complying with these regulations.
8. We allow cremains to be buried in a plot, two cremains in one plot, or a casket and a cremains in one plot.
