

**St. Francis Xavier Cemetery Regulations for
Resurrection Mausoleum (64 crypts and 24 niches)
And Columbarium (80 niches)**

1. Selling price includes the installed bronze plate stating name, year of birth and year of death.
2. A \$50.00 opening/closing fee will be charged at the time of entombment for crypts and niche purchases.
3. Niches are intended for single entombment only.
4. Crypts are intended for single entombment however a double entombment will be allowed if at least one body is cremated (preferably both due to space). A \$500.00 fee will be imposed to cover the double nameplate and the second opening and closing. Please note that there is not enough room for a full casket and urn; other arrangements must be made to make this work. Please talk to the Pastor if you intend to have a double entombment with a casket.
5. We use a standard bronze plate for all the niches and crypts. Etchings or any other nameplate will not be permissible on the crypt or niche front.
6. 15% of the price paid will be put into a perpetual care fund.
7. The Cemetery Committee may opt to purchase back crypts or niches at a later date if the individual has a valid reason to sell. St. Francis Xavier would purchase the crypt or niche at 90% of the original price paid less price paid for bronze plates if originally purchased on a pre-need basis. Transfer fees may apply.
8. The St. Francis Xavier Cemetery Committee must be notified of all transfers or sales between individual parties. A signed agreement must include St. Francis Xavier as a witness to the transfer. Transfer fees may also apply.
9. Decorations may be placed on the ground and not be attached to the crypts or niches. All decorations must be removed within a week of the celebrated day.
